WELCOME

The **PADI Open Water Diver Program** is the first in a series of diver educational programs and where your training begins. It's the first step in an adventure which will allow you to get underwater all over our wonderful planet.

The first session of the SCUBA(Self-Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus) Course will be held at a local facility. The remaining pool skills training sessions(3) will be held at one of our training facilities which your Course Director will advise you in advance of exact time and location. Keep in mind, if you have a pool available we are willing to come to you and train there at mutually agreeable times & dates.

During this Orientation Meeting (*there is no pool for this session*). We will review the program, complete some paperwork & answer any questions to get you prepared for your scuba skills training over the next 3 weeks.

This program is one in which you will:

1-Learn the academic concepts via E-learning modules which we will supply. Please be advised, if students have special needs, we will work with you to plan and give additional help.

2-Hands on Scuba Skills Training which are conducted in a pool.

3-Open Water Training Dives(Lake,Quarry or Ocean) after which you will be able to qualify for certification as a PADI Open Water Scuba Diver. The Open Water Training consists of 4 Training Dives with your PADI Instructor. These may be conducted anywhere in the world and as such involve a separate fee from your academic and pool skills training. The All American Staff will review these options with you.

PADI (Professional Association Of Diving Instructors) is an educationally based training organization that is acknowledged worldwide. Don't let this chance for adventure slip away ...let's get diving!

Tuition

The tuition for group lessons is \$579 per person. Our group classes are usually 6 or fewer students. Private lessons (1 person) are available and the tuition is \$779. Lessons for a group / family etc of more than 6 are also available. Please check with your instructor for additional information. All tuitions include the PADI E-Learning Academic Programs, use of all scuba gear, pool and instructional access.

While your Instructor will be providing your scuba equipment, all students must have their own personal gear. This would be a mask, fins and snorkel. We do recommend a wetsuit for additional warmth & comfort.

SCUBA Diving is fun and our classes fill up well in advance of the start dates. To reserve your spot(s) in the class of your choice, you may remit a deposit of \$50 with your Student Registration Form to hold your spot in class.

REFUND POLICY

Deposits are transferable should you decide to change course location or times. Make up sessions can be done privately for \$75 per session...so, try not to miss classes. Complete refunds will be made up to the second class of the 4 week course for medical reasons only. (Return a medical form with the doctor's rejection statement is required.) Refunds less \$50 administrative fee will be made up to the second class session for non-medical reasons. No refunds after the third session, however if you decide to complete the course within one year there will be no additional charge.

What to bring to the 1st session

There is no pool session for the orientation, so just bring yourself and something to take some notes!

Tuition is payable in full on or before your first in pool session.

If the student is a minor, certain forms will need to be signed by as parent or guardian. Please ask them to be there to do this at the first session.

NOTE: Pool classes on Sundays are generally held at the Ocean City Community pool from 2pm-5pm unless noted differently at orientation. Pool sessions in July and August **may be scheduled differently** to accommodate student schedules and preferences. This pool is indoors and hoever, we do recommend wearing a wet suit for the pool sessions. A wet suit is generally a necessity when we are in the outdoor pool. Your comfort is a very important part of your learning.
